Chair Report: Justin Leung

- Achieved quite a bit this year
- Managed to keep hot lunch to 3 days a week
- Spent \$58,401 this year to support student learning
 - \$16,826 - 30 iPads for Jamieson
 - \$12,600 - subsidized field trips
 - \$8,350 - Classroom supplies / support
 - \$2,623 - agendas
 - \$2,000 - school library
 - \$500 - sports equipment
- Teachers wish lists:
 - \$5,766 blue gym floor mats, volleyballs, pop-up soccer goal
 - \$3,569 Volleyball net repairs
 - \$2,100 classroom libraries
 - \$1,567 2 x canopies
 - \$1,000 Bistro tables & chairs
 - \$1,000 art drying rack
 - \$500 3D printer

- We raised \$48,000 this year, if we didn't have the iPad purchase this year, we would be net positive
 - \$28,062 Hot lunch (58%)
 - \$5,155 Carnival (11%)
 - \$4,350 Hot lunch savings (9%)
 - \$3,425 Gift cards (7%)
 - \$2,781 Concessions (6%)
 - \$1,708 Dominoes (3%)
 - \$1,096 Talent Show (2%)
 - \$1,073 GIC interest (2%)
 - \$972 Apple fundraiser (2%)
- Received gaming grant \$10,284 from BC Lotto, which gave every student \$20

Principal's Report: Cathy Thomas
