Principal's Report: Cathy Thomas

- Events in the last few months
 - Curling program

- Good results from FSA
 - Literacy - 90 % of grade 4 and 7 students are on track or extending
 - Numeracy - 91 % of grade 4 are on track or extending, 82 % of grade 7 are on track or extending
 - District data not out yet
- Division 3 had science fair. 3 students had their projects accepted for district science fair for grade 7-12 students
- Division 1 and 5 had art exhibition. Some of the art works will be on display at Oakridge Library in March

- Division 1 will be performing "As You Like It" next week

 - Parent session on March 9th evening

Treasurer's Report: Stephen Au

- Revenue still coming in strong with hot lunch and concession

 - Expenses are expected, the only items not on original budget is teachers wish list
